Julie Ashton's street, Bank Top, near the centre of Blackburn, has lots of takeaway shops that sell instant, cheap, high-calorie meals. Two of the takeaways on this street are called Paradise.

"Around here, you can get chips and a burger for a pound, with a bit of lettuce," says Ashton. "The takeaways sell so much fast food because so many customers are coming in to get the deals. The takeaways are in competition with each other."

Since 2014, the number of takeaway shops in Blackburn with Darwen has increased by 24%. The Guardian found that 38% of all food shops in the borough sell mainly fast food – that is more than anywhere else in England and 12% above the national average.

It is also one of the country's poorest areas. In Blackburn, life expectancy is lower than the national average and almost a quarter of four- and five-year-old children are overweight or obese. In Julie Ashton's street, some of the takeaways are directly opposite the local secondary school.

Blackburn now has 236 takeaways – that is one for every 625 people in the borough. So it's no surprise that there are so many offers in the windows of each takeaway.

In the town centre, one takeaway offers specials for £3, including a sugary drink. At another takeaway, customers can eat a "jumbo special" of mixed meats for £6.20. Super-value meals start at just £2.

"In a week, we have at least two or three takeaways," says Nathan Bentley, a 21-year-old unemployed Blackburn man. He thinks there are too many fast-food shops in his town. Bentley suggests the council should not allow takeaways to be open all day. "The other food businesses don't get customers if the takeaways are open all day. Some of them open at 10am. If the council controlled these opening hours, the situation might change."

Kim McConaghy, a mother of three, used to eat a takeaway once a week. She has recently given up the habit. "It was cheap and easy – we would normally get a pizza instead of going home and cooking something," she says. "But it's a vicious circle."

Blackburn with Darwen Council says it has started to limit the number of takeaway businesses by not allowing new ones to open. It also wants fast-food shops to offer customers more healthy options.

Today, Blackburn's high street is full of busy shops, cheerful dog walkers and families enjoying the summer holidays. Business is good – especially for the town's fast-food shops. The afternoon air has the aroma of ribs, veggie burgers and seven-inch pizzas from takeaway shops. But according to health experts, it's not exactly paradise.
